

Ordinal Numbers

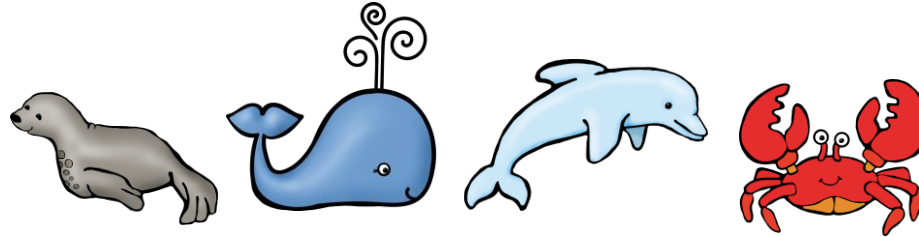
